# Recruiting Timeline



### Freshman and Sophomore



#### RECRUITING

**NCAA Regulations:** A student becomes a "prospective student-athlete".

**Update:** Email coaches on progress every 2 - 3 months.



#### **ACADEMICS**

**Guidance Counselor:** Stay on track with required NCAA core classes. **PSAT:** Take the PSAT exam spring semester of your sophomore year.



#### **VISITS**

**Unofficial Visits:** Plan visits to college campuses while on the road.

# Recruiting Timeline Junior Year





#### RECRUITING

**September 1<sup>st</sup> of Junior Year:** Coaches may contact you: phone, text, email. **July 1<sup>st</sup> after Junior Year:** Coaches may contact you in-person off campus. **NCAA Eligibility Center:** End of junior year.



#### **ACADEMICS**

**Guidance Counselor:** Stay on track with required NCAA core classes.

**Prep Class:** Take a prep class for your intended exams. (SAT, SAT 2, ACT and TOEFL)

Standardized Tests: Take the SAT, SAT 2's, ACT and TOEFL



#### **VISITS**

**Unofficial Visits:** Plan visits to college campuses while on the road.

### Senior Year



#### RECRUITING

**Communication:** Stay in frequent contact with coach and admissions.

**NCAA National Letter of Intent:** 

**Early** Eight days following the second Wednesday in November.

**Normal** Mid-April through August 1st.

NCAA Eligibility Center: Complete registration with Eligibility Center end of Senior Year.



#### **ACADEMICS**

**College Applications:** Player must submit college applications separate from any NCAA National Letter of Intent engagements.



#### **VISITS**

**Official Visits:** Player is limited to 5 official visits during senior year. An updated transcript and test scores submitted to school prior to an official visit.






